AFL To Stage Second International Cup



Planning has started for the second Australian Rules International Cup to be held in Melbourne in

August 2005 with the AFL issuing invitations to international Australian Football associations this week.

Eleven nations (Canada, Great Britain, Denmark, Ireland, New Zealand, Nauru, Papua New Guinea, Japan, Samoa, South Africa and USA) competed in the inaugural Australian Football International Cup in 2002. Ireland defeated Papua New Guinea in the Grand Final on the MCG. Following the outstanding success of the tournament, there is a high possibility of other countries joining them next year. International Cup regulations state all players must be citizens and have predominantly lived in the country concerned between the ages of 10 and 16. It is not an event for expatriate Australians, but is an event that highlights the AFL's support of grassroots football.
